Read 2 Kings 4

After reading the text together answer some of the following discussion questions.

1. Which of the stories in chapter 4 did you find most compelling?
2. What similarities do you see in these stories and some of the miracles and wonders the Gospels record?
3. How is the work of Elisha's ministry similar to what Jesus did during his ministry?
4. If these things happen today how would the stories be the same and how would they be different?
5. What do these stories tell us about God and how he operates in the world?
6. What sort of changes would you need to make to have the same sort of faith as the woman who could not pay her debt? Is there anything in these stories that caused you to think maybe you need to make some changes? If so, what?
