Invitation to the Thirsty

Leader Prep Section

- Prepare by reading through the questions and scripture passage so that you can select a few questions that are best suited to your group.
- Try to work through at least one question from each of the sections - Hook, Book, Look, Took in order to move from observation to application.
- When possible spend time in prayer for each member of your group.

Hook - Ice breaker type questions to help make the transition into the study time.

- What are some things that stood out to you from Sunday's sermon?
- What's something you're excited about this summer?

Background / Reading

Read: Isaiah 55:1-7. Does anyone have any questions about this passage? Or observations that stand out to you immediately?

Book - These questions are designed to get you into the text itself.

- What is God offering in this passage?
- Who is the "him" in v. 4?
- What is the significance in v. 5 regarding the nations?

Look - These questions will take you on a deeper look at what the passage means for us today.

- How does he tell us, his people, to respond? (Come, listen) Why does he want us to respond this way?
- What is the meaning of v. 2? What are some ways people spend their labor on what doesn't satisfy?

Took - These questions are focused on applying the big idea from the text to our lives.

- What is your fire lookout-- the thing you want most in life?
- How should we respond to God's invitation to Come and Listen? What does that look like?
- How can we both rest in God's presence, but also spend our labor on things that truly satisfy?
