- 5 When Jesus came by, he looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name. "Zacchaeus!" he said. "Quick, come down! I must be a guest in your home today." - Luke 19:5

THINK!

- Before Zacchaeus said anything to Jesus from the tree, Jesus already knew he was there and He called out his name. Even in a crowd, Jesus knows us and knows exactly where we are.
- How many of you like to climb trees? Today we are learning about a man who climbed a tree to see Jesus. I am so glad we do not need to climb a tree to see Jesus. He is right in our hearts if we ask Him to be.
