Leader Prep Section

Take time before your small group meeting to prepare by reading through the questions and scripture passage so that you can select 4-5 questions that are best suited to your group.

Try to work through at least one question from each of the sections - Hook, Book, Look, Took in order to move from observation to application.

When possible spend time in prayer for each member of your group.

Questions

Hook - Ice breaker type questions to help make the transition into the study time.

1. What is your earliest memory of Easter?
2. What is your earliest memory of understanding Jesus' resurrection?

Read Luke 24:1 – 12; 36 - 49

Book - These questions are designed to get you into the text itself.

1. What would it of been like to be those women?
2. What would it of been like to be one of the 11 disciples when Jesus appeared in the room?
3. What can we say about what Jesus is like from these passages? How does he act? What is his heart towards people?
4. How were these people changed by this encounter?
5. What questions does this passage leave you with?
6. What surprises you about this passage?

Look - These questions will take you on a deeper look at what the passage means for us today.

1. What even in your own life does this remind you of in some way?
2. Who have you known that was deeply changed by their encounter with Jesus?
3. What does it mean to live a life trusting in Jesus' resurrection?
4. How is the way Jesus encounters people today different from this passage? How is it similar?

Took - These questions are focused on applying the big idea from the text to our lives.

1. What is the good news for this this week from this passage?
2. What do you sense God saying to you either through this passage or through Sunday's worship time?
3. What does this passage make you want to pray?
4. How would you answer the question, "Where are you at with Jesus?"
