- 2. What is your earliest memory of understanding Jesus' resurrection?

## Book - These questions are designed to get you into the text itself.

- 1. What would it of been like to be those women?
- 2. What would it of been like to be one of the 11 disciples when Jesus appeared in the room?
- 3. What can we say about what Jesus is like from these passages? How does he act? What is his heart towards people?
- 4. How were these people changed by this encounter?
- 5. What questions does this passage leave you with?
- 6. What surprises you about this passage?

# Look - These questions will take you on a deeper look at what the passage means for us today.

- 1. What even in your own life does this remind you of in some way?
- 2. Who have you known that was deeply changed by their encounter with Jesus?
- 3. What does it mean to live a life trusting in Jesus' resurrection?
- 4. How is the way Jesus encounters people today different from this passage? How is it similar?

## Took - These questions are focused on applying the big idea from the text to our lives.

- 1. What is the good news for this this week from this passage?
- 2. What do you sense God saying to you either through this passage or through Sunday's worship time?
- 3. What does this passage make you want to pray?
- 4. How would you answer the question, "Where are you at with Jesus?
