Read 1 Kings 19:1-9

After reading the text together answer some of the following discussion questions.

1. Before you started did you know this story? Which parts were familiar?
2. Why, do you think, Elijah was afraid of Ahab and Jezebel after seeing what God can do?
3. How did God deal with Elijah's fear?
4. Based on your experience what does God do for those who call out to him? Especially from a place of despair.
5. How does your experience with God match with Elijah's story?
6. How does God want to use you and your story to bring light to people stuck in the dark?
7. What actions can you take to share your story with those who cross your path? What methods of sharing, other than words, can you use?
8. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you through Elijah's encounter with God?

Finish by praying together.

Reminder: Reminder: We are called to live in such a way that those around us recognize that we are patterning our lives after someone who is different. When we choose the world over our compassionate God we are on a path that leads us nowhere good. Even then, our God chooses to pursue us with love and call us back to relationship with him.
