Read 1 Kings 19:1-9

After reading the text together answer some of the following discussion questions.

- 1. Before you started did you know this story? Which parts were familiar?
- 2. Why, do you think, Elijah was afraid of Ahab and Jezebel after seeing what God can do?
- 3. How did God deal with Elijah's fear?
- 4. Based on your experience what does God do for those who call out to him? Especially from a place of despair.
- 5. How does your experience with God match with Elijah's story?
- 6. How does God want to use you and your story to bring light to people stuck in the dark?
- 7. What actions can you take to share your story with those who cross your path? What methods of sharing, other than words, can you use?
- 8. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you through Elijah's encounter with God?

Finish by praying together.
