Leader Prep Section

Take time before your small group meeting to prepare by reading through the questions and scripture passage so that you can select 4-5 questions that are best suited to your group.

Try to work through at least one question from each of the sections - Hook, Book, Look, Took in order to move from observation to application.

When possible spend time in prayer for each member of your group.

Hook - Ice breaker type questions to help make the transition into the study time.

1. What was a New Year's tradition for you growing up or a tradition now?

Read Ephesians 2:1 - 10

Questions

Book - These questions are designed to get you into the text itself.

- 1. In Paul's mind, what is the situation every human finds themselves in (vv1 3)? In other words, what is the problem?
- 2. What is the revolutionary idea that Paul communicates in verse 4-9?
- 3. Talk about the importance of the logical flow of this passage (sin, grace, good works).

Look - These questions will take you on a deeper look at what the passage means for us today.

- 1. Why do you think when Paul talks about sin here he doesn't point out the sin in others but wants his listeners to remember their own sinful pasts?
- 2. In your own words what does "saved by grace through faith" mean? Why is this so different from other ways of approaching religion?

Took - These questions are focused on applying the big idea from the text to our lives.

- 1. If you have never taken time as a group to share your salvation stories, consider doing so (or beginning to do so) tonight.
- 2. If you have already shared your salvation stories as a group before, talk about where God has rescued you over this past year.
- 3. What else do you find yourself thankful to God for when you look back on 2017?
- 4. Where do you need to trust for God as you go into 2018?

Pray for one another
