Leader Prep Section

- Prepare by reading through the questions and scripture passage so that you can select a few questions that are best suited to your group.
- Try to work through at least one question from each of the sections Hook, Book, Look, Took in order to move from observation to application.
- When possible spend time in prayer for each member of your group.

Hook - Ice breaker type questions to help make the transition into the study time.

- What are some things that stood out to you from Sunday's missionary sharing time and sermon?
- Who has been a mentor figure in your life? What is something they have taught you?

## Background / Reading

**Read: 1 John 1:5-7** Does anyone have any questions about this passage? Or observations that stand out to you immediately?

Book - These questions are designed to get you into the text itself.

- What does it mean to walk in the light in the context of spiritual friendship?
- How does walking in the light/being in relationship with God help us have fellowship with one another?

Look - These questions will take you on a deeper look at what the passage means for us today.

- How does having fellowship with each other help us experience Jesus' forgiveness in a more complete way?
- What is the relationship between having fellowship with God and having fellowship with each other?

**Took** - These questions are focused on applying the big idea from the text to our lives.

- Who is someone in your life right now who inspires you to go deeper in your relationship with God?
- Who do you consider a spiritual friend--someone you can have real conversations with and share hard things with?
- Do you find it challenging to share about spiritual things with the people in your life? What holds you back? How do you sense God wants to mature you in this area?
- Who do you think God has placed in your life to draw into fellowship/spiritual friendship?
