Hook - Ice breaker type questions to help make the transition into the study time.

• What are some things that stood out to you from Sunday's sermon?

Background / Reading Galatians 3:1 - 14

Book - These questions are designed to get you into the text itself.

- List all the questions Paul asks in this section. What is Paul trying to accomplish by the questions he asks?
- How does this section illustrate what the opposing teachers were trying to convince the Galatians of?
- How does Paul make the case for faith in Jesus over following Jewish Torah?
- How is it the Galatians are children of Abraham without being circumcised?
- Why did Jesus bear the curse and what was the result?
- Why do you think Paul puts such emphasis on the Spirit in this passage?

Look - These questions will take you on a deeper look at what the passage means for us today.

- What do followers of Jesus today have in common with Abraham?
- What do followers of Jesus today have in common with those in Galatia?
- How does is change a person's life that their primary identity is with Jesus' family and not any other people group?
- Why is it important for followers of Jesus to understand they have God's Spirit simply through trusting in Jesus? What happens if this is lost?
- What is your reaction to the idea that the God who made all things desires to dwell within people?

Took - These questions are focused on applying the big idea from the text to our lives.

- What part of God's character does he want you to know about because of this passage?
- What is the good news in your life from this passage?
- What step of trust do you feel Jesus inviting you from this passage?
- What helps you be aware and appreciate the Spirit's presence in your life?
