

## **Prayers and Proverbs**

### **Week 3 9/13/20**

**Read:** Proverbs 3:5-6

- **5** Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; **6** in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.
- (Remember, Solomon is writing this)

**Questions:**

- Who does Solomon say we need to trust?
- What will God do if we trust in Him?
- Why shouldn't we lean on our own understanding? What happens when we lean on what we know and not what God knows?

**Answers:**

- Solomon says to trust in the Lord with all our hearts. Instead of leaning on our own wisdom, we need to lean on God. If we do so, Solomon says God will make our paths straight. Why is it so important to find that straight path? Because this world is full of temptations and distractions, things that will pull us away from God if we're not careful. God wants us to rely on him so that we will not go astray. Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus, and stay on the straight path.
