Read: Proverbs 27:17

- **17** As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.

Questions:

- What do you think this verse is talking about when it says, “one person sharpens another?”
- How can we sharpen another person? How can they sharpen us?

Answers:

From scripture, we learn that being around a friend or another person, they can ‘sharpen’ us. BUT it has to be the right person. We’ve talked about having good friends before, and it is so important that we need to talk about it again! When one person sharpens another, it means a good friend can help us be better, and we can help them be better.

** Pencils need the right kind of sharpener, and so do knives, and we need the right people around us to sharpen us.
