

Prayers and Proverbs

Week 9 10/25/20

Think! When we trust in God our strong refuge and fortress, He keeps us safe in scary situations and saves us from our sins!

Read: Proverbs 18:10

- **10** The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.

What is righteous?

- Righteousness is when someone loves and obeys really well.

Questions:

- How can a name keep you safe?
- Do you think the name of Jesus can keep you safe?

Answers: It might seem silly, but think about your parents picking you up from school OR Treasureland. They use their NAMES, to pick you up so people know they are your parents.

When we are scared or needing help, we pray and talk to Jesus. We use His NAME! The Bible teaches us that if we feel like something bad is happening, we can call on the name of Jesus to protect us.

Activity:

- **3yrs-Kindergarten:** This week, color your castle crown craft and wear it proudly! It is a great reminder that God is our strong refuge and fortress.
- **1st-5th:** This week, you will have a template of a block, use the paper to make a bunch of blocks and build a strong fortress. Ask your parents for more paper if you have it, and challenge yourself to build it taller than yourself! Write the name of Jesus on the blocks as a reminder that His name protects you.

Prayer:

Dear Lord, thank You for being all that we need. Our strong tower. A place of refuge where we can partake in the fullness of You. You are everything for every need. AMEN!

Video Idea:

- Ask what righteousness is...
- Have them read the verse?
- The fortress (in the Junior's backyard) will be named Jesus... We run to it to be safe.
