- " God wanted people to remember: It is wonderful to live with him... but because of your sin, you can't come in. So He told the people to build a special building called his temple, where He would live. In the middle of the temple was the most wonderful place in the world - the place where God was, with nothing bad and nothing sad." - The Garden, The Curtain and The Cross.

THINK!

- Last week, your families received a book and this week we are looking at a special part in that book called the Temple.
- The temple was a place where people could go to be with God. This temple was beautiful. In the temple was a curtain and it was there because Jesus hadn't come to save us from our sins yet, and we couldn't yet be with Jesus and His presence. The curtain helped to keep people out of the temple, because we still had our sin.
- That is why Jesus came to give us a gift. Jesus' gift was to take our sin so we could be with Him!
