READ: MARK 5:35-43 NLT

- 41 Holding her hand, he said to her,
"Talitha koum," which means "Little girl, get
up!" 42 And the girl, who was twelve years
old, immediately stood up and walked
around! They were overwhelmed and
totally amazed.

- Religious leaders back in the day did not like Jesus very much. They heard stories of the miracles that Jesus had done and they were not happy about them.
- Jairus was a father and synagogue worker who was desperate for Jesus to heal his daughter. She was too sick to get better with medicine but Jairus had heard stories of the miracles that Jesus had done. Jairus went to Him and begged Jesus to heal her. Verse 36 says that Jesus told him, "Don't be afraid. Just have faith." Then, all Jesus needed to do was speak, and after telling the girl to get up. she immediately stood up and walked!

- Jesus made sure that the people in the room with Him did not tell anyone what had happened.
