- "I am Jesus." Said the voice. "When you hurt my friends, you are hurting me too. Go to the city, I'll tell you what to do."
- After the voice was gone, Saul opened his eyes and realized he was blind. He had someone guide him to the city, where he met a man named Ananias. Ananias loved Jesus, but Jesus had told Ananias to pray for Saul to make him see again. Ananias was sacred because Saul had been the one to hurt people like Ananias.
