Alpha






Heaven and Earth

Be Transformed - Group Study

WHEN: Wednesday Evening


WHERE: North County LIFESTAGE: Any Adult

DESCRIPTION: This new small group will connect weekly to support one another through a heart transformation process directed by Rock House Center's book "Be Transformed". The Robinsons have been deeply impacted by the experience and are excited to share it with the Hillcrest community. A 16 week commitment to complete the workbook, this study brings God's healing to our lives by uncovering the root causes of negative emotions and unwanted behaviors. Most of this process takes place independently through daily reflection guided by the book, with the group coming together once a week to discuss. Due to the sensitive nature, the group is limited to 10 persons and is child-free (no children present and no child care provided onsite). Robby and Samantha Robinson will be facilitating this group; register to ask questions or learn more.

Samantha's Testimony: "Through my own efforts, I tried everything to get off life's emotional rollercoaster. Self-reliance controlled me because I believed it was the only answer. If I could just make myself be a better person, do the right things relentlessly, then I'd be at peace! Thankfully, God was gracious and knew what I needed: heart transformation. Finally, I experienced that 'His yolk is easy, and His burden is light'. By offering my heart to Him, He could start the clearing out the heartache and fill it with His peace."

Embodied - Book Study

WHEN: Tuesday Evening

WHERE: South Bellingham LIFESTAGE: Any Adult

DESCRIPTION: If someone experiences incongruence between their biological sex and their internal sense of self, which one determines who they are - and why? This is the driving question Preston Sprinkle explores in his book Embodied. In this six week study, we will learn how the culture is using gender identity terminology, where we find truths about gender in scripture and the life of Jesus, and how we can equip ourselves to have conversations full of grace and truth in an evolving cultural climate. This will be a space to both learn and to share more personally, as more and more of us have a lived experience of gender distress, or walk closely with a loved one who does. 
HILLCREST CREATES
